The **upper left hand graph** is studying time. We expect this to be right skewed --- many students study little or none at all (not my class!!); a few study longer. The **lower right graph** represents students' heights --- expect variation, but no particular skewness. The other graphs represent "handedness" and gender. Right-handed students should outnumber left-handed students (as in the regular population) and right-handedness was represented at "0" on the x-axis.
